Federal multi-candidate PACs may donate up to a maximum of \$5,000 for the primary election and \$5,000 for the general election.

Contributions from corporations, labor unions, federal government contractors, national banks and foreign nationals without permanent residency status are prohibited. Federal law requires political committees to report the name, mailing address and employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$2,400 an election cycle.

To comply with Federal law, we must use our best efforts to obtain, maintain, and submit the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 per calendar year.
